I had the joy of assistance from the excellent infectologist at Hospital Aliança, Dr. Adriano and other infectologists.

The adoption of protocols and supportive treatment allowed the crossing. No, it's not a little cold, but a virus that can be lethal.

It was clear that science with its recommendations such as: Social distance; isolation; the use of soap and gel alcohol as care and the use of a mask, help to break the spread of the viral curve, allowing health authorities to prepare the health network, avoid chaos and save lives. Too bad the President of the Republic does not care about the Brazillian lives and prefers to count corpses. Such inhumanity.

I make this report in thanks to the doctors.

Also as a token of appreciation to all central unions leaders of Brazil; global leaders of the ICM who expressed solidarity, support and appreciation. To friends, family, evangelical and Catholic leaders for their prayers; federal and state deputies from different parties, mayors and councilors, in short, from construction workers and my fellow officers and friends.

We won a stage and I will remain in quarantine.
